### Operation Empathy

The Syrian civil war has been raging for six years now and has caused an extreme humanitarian crisis. According to the UN, about 12.5 million Syrians have been displaced from their homes and are in constant mortal danger due to lack of basic supplies.

In the 69 months of fighting in Syria about **450 thousand people** have been killed. Of these, one hundred thousand were civilians and 16,000 were children.

About 12.5 million Syrian civilians, **60% of the Syrian population**, mostly women and children, have been displaced from their **homes** since the beginning of the war and are living without appropriate shelter.

Most of the displaced refugees **lack basic supplies** that are **critical** for surviving the cold winter.

The The General Federation of Working and Studying Youth (NOAL), Dror Israel and the Combat Genocide Association are leading a national, broad operation to collect winter supplies - **supplies that can save lives.**

The operation focuses on collecting supplies such as winter **coats, blankets, boots and warm shoes, gloves, mittens and sleeping bags.** The supplies will be transferred to the refugees by an organization that aids women and children and does not participate in the fighting.

## How will the operation take place?

A national operation for collecting supplies will take place until January 12th. The goal of the operation is to ease the harsh conditions of Syrian refugees and displaced persons, and even save lives. Supplies can be brought to any of the 16 collection facilities around the country, which are open to the public. Details can be found on our website or on Facebook at "מבצע חום אנושי". The supplies will be sorted and packed by volunteers at the distribution sites. At the end of the operation the supplies will be transferred to the refugees with the help of an aid organization.

## Packing guidelines:

Several guidelines must be followed to ensure the safety of the refugees and displaced persons who will receive the supplies

The operation will collect winter supplies only: coats, warm shoes or boots, gloves, mittens, blankets and sleeping bags.

Items cannot be collected if they have Israeli logos or Hebrew writing.

All tags inside the items must be removed.

Items must be laundered at 60 degrees Celsius and fully dried before donation.

Items should be delivered to collection facilities in neat bags or boxes after preliminary inspection for adherence to guidelines.

Only items in good condition can be accepted.

Items should be packed according to size and sorted by gender:
